### 2019 Summary

- Most vegetation doing well
- Hydrilla increased at Beachwoods Flats, I-85, Great Creek
- Expansion outside of exclosures
  - Spatterdock in Beachwoods Flats, Great Creek, Lower Poplar
  - Spatterdock, watersheild, lily, etc. in Big Stone House
- Coontail established in many exclosures
- Plants in coves without exclosures did not fair as well as ones with exclosures.



### Proposed 2020 Re-vegetation

- Spring Survey
- Revegetation effort June 8<sup>th</sup> 12<sup>th</sup>
- Maintenance at existing re-vegetation sites
  - Including increasing height of existing exclosures
- Plant outside of cages (Little Stone House, Still House, Kings Branch, Great Creek, Upper Poplar, Upper Flats)
- Expand existing sites (Beachwood Flats)



### Proposed 2020 Re-vegetation

- New Sites Eelgrass in lower lake
- Consider LGWCC treat exclosures at Beachwood to reduce competition with Hydrilla
- Fall Survey
